Errata: In last month's article on the clock drive speed control there were a few errors. Please make the following corrections.

In the oscillator portion of the schematic, V2, the power amp should have been identified as a 50C5. Control grid is connected to pins 2 and 5, either of which may be used. Pin 1 is internally connected to both cathode and suppressor grid. In Hole 3, C3 and C6 are made from 3 .001 μ fd. units in parallel.

In the last sentence of the article, the word not should be omitted. The isolating power transformer, if used, should be installed between the line plug and the rest of the circuit.
